

The Chair will serve a 2-year term after which the Vice-Chair will have the option of assuming the role of Chair and a new Vice-Chair will be selected. The Chair and Vice-Chair positions will be open to anyone who's served on the CAC for at least one year.

The roles will be decided using the following approach:

- self-nomination through an Expression of Interest
- written nomination by a CAC member or current Chair/Vice-Chair

Informal interviews with interested candidates will be conducted by a panel, which may include the current CAC Chair/Vice-Chair, the KW4 Executive Director, a current CAC member, and a representative from the KW4 OHT Steering Committee.

The CAC meets from September to June. It is expected that you will also spend time connecting with members of your community outside of these meetings to seek their input on various social and health-related issues.
